



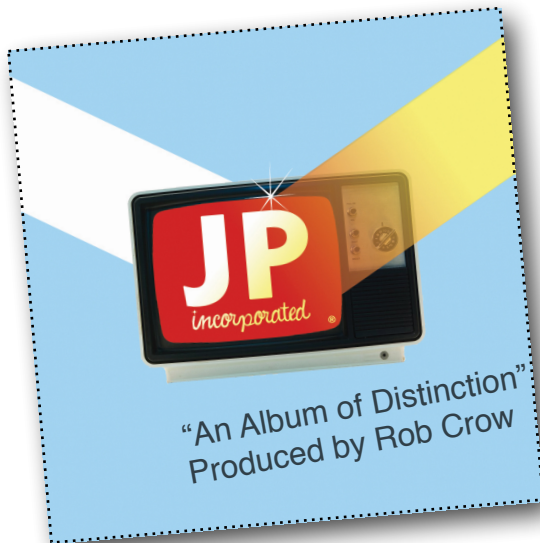
JP Incorporated
